## 1. Development and Prevention of Malignant Tumours (Cancer)

The reason and motivation for me in publishing these results is the combination of studying many scientific publications and practical data about a time period between 1945 and today, as well as my own personal experiences. I began my descriptive scientific research in the early 1990s in the medical library of Utrecht University. As I progressed in my research, more and more important aspects emerged that formed an ever more conclusive, logical and interconnected whole. In this particular study, they led to the conviction and the conclusion that there is a clear correlation between the causes and effects of the most common types of malignant tumours (cancer).

It became apparent to me, as early as 1994, that there is a causal relation between the presence of fungus in the body (the yeast *Candida Albicans*, including its many subspecies) and the growth of tumours. These tumours developed in an increasing number of people after World War II, and after the mid-1960s in particular. Tumours in the form of breast cancer, prostate cancer, cervical cancer, colorectal cancer, leukaemia. Tumours that have become a true plague for humanity.

If we travel back in history, we quickly learn that cancer was virtually non-existent. It was not noticeable in the Middle Ages, nor in Ancient Egypt. Cancer is a plague that has been tormenting humanity only in recent decades!

### **Otto Warburg, biochemist 1924: *Cancer is a yeast***

As a researcher and writer/publicist, I learned I was not the only one who noticed there had to be a correlation between the development of cancer and the yeast *Candida Albicans*.

As early as 1924, the German biochemist Otto Warburg postulated *that cancer consists of primitive cells that get their energy from glucose, without requiring oxygen, in a process called fermentation*. Otto Warburg realised that it was about a type of yeast, not a bacteria or virus. *Candida Albicans* is a yeast (often erroneously referred to as a fungus) that lives on glucose, on sugars.

### **Dr Tullio Simoncini, oncologist 2005: Cancer caused by Yeast**

Otto Warburg was apparently very much ahead of his time with his ideas, because they went largely unnoticed for the next 80 years. It was not until around 2005 that the leading Italian oncologist Dr Tullio Simoncini suddenly stated that “cancer is essentially caused by a fungus” (*Candida Albicans*).
